# McKesson Foundation

- **We do not consider proposals for:**

- Religious organizations that actively proselytize a particular religious point of view or philosophy or only serve people of their faith
- Veterans, labor, athletic or fraternal groups (except when these groups provide needed services to the community-at-large, such as a soup kitchen).
- Direct grants or scholarships to individuals
- Lobbying
- Projects that do not directly benefit communities within a 50 mile radius of our Regional Grant Committee locations
- Endowment funds

# The Process

- All potential grantees are required to fill out our online grant application form.
- Qualifications: 501c3 and within 50 miles of a McKesson facility.
- The McKesson Foundation can fund an agency for three consecutive years, after which the nonprofit is required to take a one year break from funding before reapplying.

# Timeline of Events

- April - July
  - Employees encourage non-profit organizations to apply online for grants
- August
  - Committee meets to discuss the grant proposals already received
  - Develop a list of additional agencies; invite them to apply for a grant
- September – November
  - Any additional information needed is gathered from the organizations and potentially site visits are performed
  - Selected organizations are invited to McKesson to present to the grant committee
  - Each committee member fills out an evaluation tool for each applicant
- December – January
  - Evaluation tool scores are tabulated
  - Recommendations are submitted to the corporate office for approvals
- February – March
  - Agencies are notified of grant; checks are distributed
  - Invited to attend Employee Community days at McKesson
